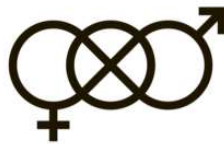


How well do you know gender words?

| 1. agender | a. applies to a person whose gender identity is not fixed |
| 2. bi-gender | b. an umbrella term to describe those who do not feel exclusively male or female |
| 3. cisgender | c. similar to "non-binary" - some people regard "queer" as offensive, others embrace it |
| 4. enby | d. applies to a person whose gender is different from their "assigned" sex at birth |
| 5. gender fluid | e. applies to someone whose gender matches their "assigned" sex at birth (i.e. someone who is not transgender) |
| 6. genderqueer | f. applies to someone who doesn't identify as male or female (AU English) |
| 7. Mx | g. applies to those with no gender identity or a neutral identity |
| 8. nibling | h. applies to those who experience two gender identities, either at the same time or varying between the two |
| 9. non-binary | i. a baby raised without a designated gender or stereotypical concepts of gender being imposed |
| 10. theyby | j. a child of your sibling (= brother or sister) |
| 11. transgender | k. a title used before a surname or full name to refer to a person of unspecified or non-binary gender |
